Sub: Implementation of 'Mo Sarkar' in Revenue & D.M. Department- disposal of cases pending beyond ORTPS timeline regarding.

Ref: D.O. letter No.2100/R&DM dated 10.01.2020.

Madam / Sir,

Through the referenced D.O letter, all Collectors were advised to personally look into the disposal of all pending cases like mutation, conversion, partition of land u/s 19(1)(C) of OLR Act and applications for issue of Miscellaneous and Caste Certificates through e-District portal, etc. by Tahasildars. It is observed during the course of Video Conference held on 24.01.2020 that some cases coming under the ambit of ORTPS Act are pending beyond ORTPS timeline. In order to implement 'Mo Sarkar' in Revenue and DM Department, all cases pending beyond ORTPS timeline has to be disposed of in a fair and transparent manner in accordance with the law by **5th February, 2020**. After 5th February, 2020, disposal of any case shall not exceed the ORTPS time limit.


Collectors, ADMs and Sub-Collectors shall review and monitor the disposal of cases on daily basis **to achieve zero pendency without fail within the designated timeline.**
