On being duly satisfied, the request for change may be approved / rejected by the client within 7 days of receipt of the same.</p> <p>Once the proposal for replacement is accepted, the consultant must replace the professional within 7 days of the communication of such approval. Client reserves the right to invoke the right to claim liquidated damages in case of failure of the Consultant to provide replacement personnel to the satisfaction of the Client after 2 such attempts.</p> <p>Further, acceptance of such replacement by the client shall not relieve the consultant from responsibility for failure to meet the requirements of the contract. Any change in key professionals without due approval by the Authority will lead to implication of liquidated damages of 10% of the contract value.</p>
